## Motion

The Sunshine Canyon Community Amenities Trust Fund provides funds for financing community amenities within the City of Los Angeles, within five miles of the Sunshine Canyon Landfill.

El Oro Way Elementary School is in the process of building a nature habitat and in need of funds. Nature habitats provide opportunities for experiential and hands-on learning. Students can directly observe, interact with, and learn about the natural world, ecosystems, and wildlife, which can enhance their understanding and appreciation of science and the environment.

Sufficient funds are available in Sunshine Canyon Community Amenities Trust Fund which could be used for this purpose.

**I THEREFORE MOVE** that the Council RESOLVE that \$10,000 in the Sunshine Canyon Community Amenities Trust Fund No. 699-14 be allocated to assist El Oro Way Elementary School to obtain much needed equipment.

**I FURTHER MOVE** that the City Clerk be directed to prepare and process the necessary document(s) with, and/or payment(s) to El Oro Way PTA, or any other agency or organization, as appropriate, in the above amount, from the above source, and for the above purpose, subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to form, if needed; and that, if needed, the Council member of the Twelfth District be authorized to execute any such documents on behalf of the City.

**I FURTHER MOVE** that the City Clerk be authorized to make any technical corrections or clarifications to the above fund transfer instructions in order to effectuate the intent of this Motion.
