

HOUSING AND HOMELESSNESS REPORT relative to United to House LA (ULA) revenues collected above the \$150 million approved in the Fiscal Year (FY) 2023-24 budget and the disbursement consistent with the ULA Ordinance and City financial policies, and related matters.

Recommendations for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Blumenfield - Soto-Martinez, Raman):

1. INSTRUCT the Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA) and the City Administrative Officer (CAO), with the assistance of the Los Angeles Housing Department (LAHD), to report to the Council within 60 days with recommendations on ULA revenues collected above the \$150 million approved in the FY 2023-24 budget and how revenues can be disbursed in a manner consistent with the ULA Ordinance and City financial policies.
2. REQUEST the ULA Citizen Oversight Committee, with the assistance of the LAHD, to provide recommendations for program allocations above \$150 million for FY 2023-24 and for FY 2024-25.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the CAO nor the CLA has completed a financial analysis of this report.
