Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Nazarian – Yaroslavsky):

REQUEST the LADWP to report to Council on its existing protocols and procedures for LADWP infrastructure, particularly reservoir maintenance, how these measures can be made adaptable to account for extreme weather events and the longer-term impact of increasing climate change, such as the Santa Ana winds that blow yearly; and what contingencies are in place for our water conveyance systems in emergency situations.
