REQUEST the City Attorney to prepare and present an enabling ordinance incorporating Los Angeles County Code, sections 11.02.085 through 11.41.045, Ordinance entitled "Addressing Medical Debt Through Data Collection," as amended by Los Angeles County Ordinance 2024-0048 to authorize the County's Department of Public Health to collect and publish data and policies on debt collection and financial assistance activities from hospitals operating in the City in a manner consistent with its actions in the County of Los Angeles.
