

HOUSING AND HOMELESSNESS COMMITTEE REPORT relative to authorizing the Housing Authority of the City of Los Angeles (HACLA) to use Payment in Lieu of Taxes (PILOT) funds for resident services programs at various HACLA public housing developments for Calendar Years 2024 through 2026.

Recommendation for Council action:

AUTHORIZE the HACLA to use PILOT funds for resident services programs for Calendar Years 2024 through 2026, including jobs for youth, recreation and education programs, computer learning center services, and security camera maintenance at various public housing developments, as detailed in the December 5, 2023 HCLA report, attached to Council file No. 23-1397.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the HACLA. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted

Summary:

At a regular meeting held on January 17, 2024, your Housing and Homelessness Committee considered a HACLA report dated December 5, 2023 relative to authorizing the HACLA to use PILOT funds to provide resident services programs at various HACLA public housing developments for Calendar Years 2024 through 2026. Such resident services programs include youth employment, public safety infrastructure, computer learning centers, and recreation and education programs. After providing an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended to approve the recommendation contained in the HACLA report, as detailed above. This matter is now submitted to the Council for consideration.
