

TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE REPORT relative to revising the Streets of Significance (SOS) for the Purple Line Extension Project by the Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority (Metro).

Recommendation for Council action:

AUTHORIZE the City Engineer, Chair of the Transportation Construction Traffic Management Committee, to revise the SOS within the existing Impact Area “Q” of the Major Transit and Transportation Construction Impact Areas for the Metro’s Purple Line Extension Project, Section 1.

Fiscal Impact Statement: The Board of Public Works reports that there is no impact to the General Fund. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

On January 22, 2025, your Transportation Committee considered a December 18, 2024 report from the Board of Public Works relative to revising the SOS for the Metro’s Purple Line Extension Project. According to the report, Metro’s Purple Line Extension Project will extend the existing Purple Line subway westward to terminate near the Veterans Administration Hospital in Westwood. Section 1 extends the subway from the existing Wilshire/Western Station westward along Wilshire Boulevard, ending within the City of Beverly Hills limits, near the Wilshire/La Cienega intersection. Metro has requested the revision to Impact Area “Q” to assist with the efficient movement of traffic and to minimize disruptions to the travelling public within the Project vicinity. After consideration and having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Committee moved to recommend approval of the report recommendations. This matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
