

HOUSING AND HOMELESSNESS COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the maintenance and operation of recreational facilities located at Housing Authority of the City of Los Angeles (HACLA) sites citywide.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Motion (McOsker – Blumenfield):

INSTRUCT HACLA, with assistance from the City Administrative Officer (CAO), to report to Council on the current maintenance and operation of the recreational facilities (inclusive of fields, courts and community gardens) located at HACLA sites citywide, specific to where City-funded programming occurs. The report should include:

- a. The name of the entity or organization that is in charge of maintenance related to the aforementioned facilities.
- b. The related maintenance plans with their associated costs and timelines for maintenance or repair related to the aforementioned facilities.
- c. Avenues for further collaboration between entities outside of the City, such as non-profit organizations and City entities, specifically HACLA, to ensure regular maintenance for the aforementioned facilities.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the CAO nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

SUMMARY
