Honorable Councilmembers:

I would like to express my unwavering support for Agenda Item #3, Bonseph-Helinet Van Nuys airport lease. Helinet aviation has based operations at the Van Nuys Airport (VNY) for 37 years. Throughout that time, we have devoted incalculable resources serving the greater Los Angeles area with helicopter transportation services. Most notably, our charitable donations to Children's Hospital Los Angeles (CHLA). Each year, Helinet conducts in excess of 350 CHLA flights transporting critically ill children, exceeding 11,000 transports to date.



In addition to performing the CHLA mission, Helinet is fully committed and engaged in air and ground transportation services supporting several local area hospital organ transplant teams and conducts nearly 1,000 lifesaving flights per year.



These flights require incredibly detailed planning and precise execution to ensure patients have the greatest chance of success.

The ability to offer some of the world's best transplant care attracts world-class surgeons and patients seeking top tier care. Helinet is proud to be part of the infrastructure that makes Los Angeles a highly desirable destination.

Helinet's facility is outdated, grossly inadequate, in poor condition, and in some areas, downright unsafe. Air Center entered into the facility lease with LAWA over fifty two years ago and has failed to make even the most minimal investments in property upkeep.
