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Comments for Public Posting: I am a CD5 resident of 27 years and owner of 4 properties in CD, including my home adjacent to Rancho Park and an investment property within 1,000 feet of PCEC's Pico Doheny drill site which had a surface oil spill lat year. Councilmembers: PCEC's Pipeline Franchise Agreement which expired five years ago should not be renewed by the City at all, unless the City negotiates a renewal of no longer than 48 months (before the July 2028 Olympics!) (i) to commence and continuously perdorm well plugging and orderly decommissioning of all facilities at West Pico and Doheny with firm deadlines and automatic consequences for delay, and (ii) to post a 3rd party insurance or surety company payment and performance bond in favor of the City to pay for site closure if PCEC defaults.
