

HOUSING AND HOMELESSNESS COMMITTEE REPORT relative to directing the Los Angeles Housing Department (LAHD) to report on a holistic investment strategy to create the permanent and interim housing needed to significantly reduce and ultimately end homelessness in the City; and related matters.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Raman – Yaroslavsky):

DIRECT the LAHD to report to Council in 30 days regarding a holistic investment strategy to create the permanent and interim housing needed to significantly reduce and ultimately end homelessness in the City. The plan should include:

- a. Recommendations on the size of investment needed given the projected size of the population of persons experiencing unsheltered homelessness in the City on a year by year basis.
- b. Recommendations on the housing typologies (permanent and interim) to target for investment.
- c. Projection of the number of housing units generated by investment.
- d. Projection of additional outside dollars the City will need to leverage.
- e. Identification of funding gaps.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.
