

ECONOMIC, COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AND JOBS COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the workers affected by the Phillips 66 refinery closure in Los Angeles, next steps for remediation and reuse of the site with a timeline and cost estimates and personnel needs to assess, clean up, and revitalize potential impacts onsite; and related matters.

Recommendations for Council action, as initiated by Motion (McOsker, Yaroslavsky - Krekorian):

1. CONCUR with the action taken by the Energy and Environment Committee on November 12, 2024, attached to Council file No. 24-1314.
2. REQUEST the Office of Petroleum and Natural Gas Administration, with assistance from the Bureau of Sanitation Citywide Brownfields Program and input from the Department of City Planning and the Port of Los Angeles, to include information and an analysis on an adjacent parcel, the Rancho LPG tanks, in the closure report. This should include a roadmap for abatement and closure of the use, including a timeline for remediation of the site.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.
