

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to acceptance of the 2021 Internet Crimes Against Children (ICAC) Task Force Grant Award extension.

Recommendations for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

1. AUTHORIZE the Chief of Police, or his designee, to accept the United States Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention's approval of a no-cost extension for the 2021 Internet Crimes Against Children(ICAC) Task Force Program, extending the award period from September 30, 2024 to September 30, 2025.
2. AUTHORIZE the Los Angeles Police Department to prepare Controller instructions for any technical adjustments, subject to the approval of the City Administrative Officer, and AUTHORIZE the Controller to implement the instructions.

Fiscal Impact Statement: The CAO reports that approval of the recommendations within this report will have no additional impact to the General Fund and will allow for the expenditure of the 2021 Internet Crimes Against Children (ICAC) Task Force Grant award totaling \$3,188,999 from the Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention, United States Department of Justice. No matching funds are required for this grant. There is no impact to the General Fund as a result of these recommendations.

Financial Policies Statement: The CAO reports that the recommendations in this report are in compliance with the City's Financial Policies in that, to the extent possible, all grant funds will be utilized for grant-eligible activities.
