

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the status of the Cadet Program, the Policy Academy Magnet Schools (PAMS) Program, the Associated Community Officer Program (ACOP) and the Police Orientation Preparation Program (POPP), including program elements, participation and enrollment levels, and related matters.

Recommendations for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Rodriguez – Krekorian):

1. INSTRUCT the Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD) to report on the current status of the Cadet Program, PAMS Program, ACOP, and the POPP, including program elements, participation and enrollment levels, and how these programs work collectively to provide viable pathways for youth to pursue law enforcement careers with the Department and thereby assist the Department in meeting its recruitment objectives.
2. INSTRUCT the LAPD to report on options to expand participation in these programs; and bridge any potential program gaps which may exist. The expansion of these programs may also include the development of public awareness/outreach campaigns and incentives in order to increase participation rates.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.
