Summary: The Board of the Studio City Neighborhood Council (SCNC) supports Council File 22-1475 to coordinate use of state funds granted to Medi-Cal providers in LA County to meet the local needs and goals with regard to homelessness, housing navigation and mental health services in conjunction with the Los Angeles Homeless Authority (LAHSA). This motion coordinates the efforts of California Department of Healthcare Services (DHCS), Medi-Cal Home and Community-Based Services (HCBS) Spending Plan, and LAHSA. DHCS has provided a one-time allocation of \$1.288 billion dollars to fund Homeless programs through Medi-Cal. It is anticipated that two Medi-Cal Providers in LA County will receive \$405 million dollars, which can be spent on their program, the Housing and Homelessness Incentive Program (HHIP). The motion seeks to find ways to partner and coordinate priorities with LAHSA, especially in terms of housing navigation, and to identify funding to continue expanding street medicine and mobile health/mental health van programs in the city.
