

**MOTION**

On August 7, 2019, the City Council adopted the City Engineer's Report dated November 13, 2017 for the vacation of the northwesterly 55 feet of Park Drive from approximately 260 feet southwesterly of Baxter Street to approximately 323 feet southwesterly of Baxter Street (VAC- E1401315). (CF 17-0857).


The applicant for this vacation has cleared all conditions in the City Engineer's Report apart from Number 7. Condition Number 7 of this Vacation requires that "street lighting facilities be installed as required by the Bureau of Street Lighting." As of January 15, 2025, Vacation E1401315 has expired without all the conditions being cleared, meaning that the street vacation process technically was not finalized.

Given the hillside location next to Elysian Park, our office determined that the installation of these street lighting facilities is not necessary to complete this vacation.


I THEREFORE MOVE that the street vacation proceedings for a portion of Park Drive from approximately 260 feet southwesterly of Baxter Street to approximately 323 feet southwesterly of Baxter Street (VAC- E1401315) be re-initiated pursuant to California Streets and Highways Code, Division 9, Part 3, Public Streets, Highways and Service Easements Vacation Law.

I FURTHER MOVE that the Bureau of Engineering be directed to process this vacation request under Council File No. 17-0857, Engineering Work Order No. VAC- E1401315, and apply the conditions established under the Council Action of August 7, 2019 relative to Council File 17-0857 excepting condition 7 as contained in the Bureau of Engineering report dated November 13, 2017.
