Comments for Public Posting: I am a life long resident of the neighborhood near the West Pico facility and a former board member of the neighborhood council that represents the area. There is ample evidence that the facility has violated past agreements with the city and done activities on the site without authorization. The city does not have the appropriate staff and resources to perform inspections and enforce compliance. The facility had an oil leak recently, proving again that they are not good stewards of the site. This site is very close to schools, synagogues, and homes. My children live near the site and I am afraid of impacts it may have on their health. The city has met its agreements - the franchise agreement for the pipeline has been met for the duration of its term. This agreement must be allowed to lapse and the site must close and halt operations as soon as possible.
