I learned the City plans to install large digital billboards at several locations, including at the 90 freeway intersection with Culver Boulevard.

I agree with Mike Bonin's June 1, 2022 Comment Letter: The proposed project is clearly for revenue generation purposes, digital billboards are self-evidently dangerous, and the Ballona Wetlands are a critical coastal resource.

I am strongly opposed to this idea. Having lived in this area for the past 28 years, the wetlands are a vital part of our ecosystem. Any light pollution that disrupts the delicate balance for animals and plants is bad for our environment. I would hope that we have learned something about the importance of considering our impact on the world around us with all of the evidence of climate change.
