

GOVERNMENT OPERATIONS COMMITTEE REPORT and ORDINANCE FIRST CONSIDERATION relative to amending Section 10.15(c) of Article 2, Chapter 1, Division 10 of the Los Angeles Administrative Code (LAAC) to allow notices inviting bids and proposals to be given by publication in the City's online procurement solicitation platform.

Recommendation for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

PRESENT and ADOPT the accompanying ORDINANCE dated October 23, 2024 amending Section 10.15(c) of Article 2, Chapter 1, Division 10 of the LAAC to allow notices inviting bids and proposals to be given by publication in the City's online procurement solicitation platform.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the City Attorney. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

On November 22 2024, your Committee considered an October 23, 2024 City Attorney report and Ordinance relative to amending LAAC Section 10.15(c) to allow notices inviting bids and proposals to be given by publication in the City's online procurement solicitation platform. According to the City Attorney, Charter Section 371(d) provides that notices inviting bids or proposals shall be published at least once in a daily newspaper circulated in the City, or be given by a method prescribed by ordinance. The proposed Ordinance amends Section 10.15(c) of Article 2, Chapter 1, Division 10 of the LAAC to allow notices inviting bids or proposals to be given through publication in the City's online procurement solicitation platform, such as the Regional Alliance Marketplace for Procurement or any other successor platform. After consideration and having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Committee moved to recommend approval of the Ordinance. This matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
