

COMMUNICATION FROM CHAIR, PERSONNEL, AUDITS, AND HIRING COMMITTEE and ORDINANCE FIRST CONSIDERATION relative to amending Section 31.00 of Chapter III of the Los Angeles Municipal Code (LAMC) to adopt the Los Angeles County Ordinance prohibiting retaliation for reporting public health violations, and authorizing County enforcement of the anti-retaliation provisions to protect workers within the City of Los Angeles from retaliation for reporting public health concerns.

Recommendation for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

PRESENT and ADOPT the accompanying ORDINANCE dated September 13, 2024 amending Section 31.00 of Chapter III of the LAMC to adopt the Los Angeles County Ordinance prohibiting retaliation for reporting public health violations, and authorizing County enforcement of the anti-retaliation provisions to protect workers within the City of Los Angeles from retaliation for reporting public health concerns.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the City Attorney. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Summary:

On October 1, 2024, the Chair of the Personnel, Audits, and Hiring Committee considered a September 13, 2024 City Attorney report and Ordinance relative to amending LAMC Section 31.00 to adopt the Los Angeles County Ordinance prohibiting retaliation for reporting public health violations, and authorizing County enforcement of the anti-retaliation provisions to protect workers within the City of Los Angeles from retaliation for reporting public health concerns. On April 19, 2024, Council requested the City Attorney prepare and present an Ordinance to amend the LAMC as detailed in the above recommendation. Under consideration is said Ordinance. After consideration, the Committee Chair moved to recommend approval of the Ordinance as detailed in the above recommendation. This matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
