DISCUSSION

This donation will fund contractually based fees for consultancy services to be provided by Mr. Arif Alikhan, as a Special Advisor to the Chief of Police. Mr. Alikhan will be compensated at a rate of \$20,000 per month. The term of the agreement will be for a period of six months, extendable up to one year upon mutual agreement of both parties. The Special Advisor will focus on risk management and harm reduction strategies, Department programs, and other critical areas.

The Los Angeles Police Foundation is an independent, not-for-profit organization that provides critical resources and vital support to the LAPD. From essential equipment and state-of-the-art technology to specialized training and innovative programs that would otherwise be unfunded, the Foundation provides funding that directly improves public safety, impacts officer readiness, and enhances the quality of life of all members of the community. As the largest source of private support for the LAPD, the Foundation is passionately dedicated to ensuring that Los Angeles remains America's safest major city. Since being established in 1998, the Foundation has invested tens of millions of dollars in hundreds of LAPD initiatives that promote excellence, expand capabilities, strengthen neighborhoods and create opportunities for at-risk youth. It is requested that the Office of the Chief of Staff be approved for a \$240,000.00 grant from the Los Angeles Police Foundation to fund contractually based fees for consultancy services to be provided by Mr. Arif Alikhan, as a Special Advisor to the Chief of Police.

This Special Advisor would focus on issues regarding risk management and harm reduction strategies, Department programs, and other critical issues. The Special Advisor will provide advice and guidance on issues related to Constitutional Policing, executive leadership, and management to the Chief of Police.

Arif Alikhan is a nationally recognized expert on policing, homeland security, and counterterrorism with a distinguished 25-year career in senior policy, legal, and operational positions with the United States Department of Justice, Department of Homeland Security, and the City of Los Angeles.

This grant will be instrumental in providing assistance and advice to the Chief of Police on critical Department matters. Additionally, the Special Advisor would serve to aid in the transition to the newly-selected Chief of Police. The Special Advisor is a former Director of the Office of Constitutional Policing and Policy and brings a breadth of institutional knowledge and experience to help guide the new Chief of Police.

The services provided by this contact will serve to better the Department, lessen risk management factors, and improve the overall quality of the work done by the Department. By advising during the transition period of a new Chief of Police, this Special Advisor will ensure stability and continuity despite organizational challenges.
