

NEIGHBORHOODS AND COMMUNITY ENRICHMENT COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the proposed agreement with Pete Brown Junior Tennis Program (PBJTP) and the non-exclusive use of tennis courts at Jackie Tatum Harvard Recreation Center and Saint Andrews Recreation Center, for the youth tennis program.

Recommendation for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

AUTHORIZE the General Manager, Department of Recreation and Parks (RAP) to approve the proposed three year agreement (Agreement) between the RAP and the PBJTP, a 501(c)(3) non-profit corporation, for the non-exclusive use of four tennis courts at Jackie Tatum Harvard Recreation Center located at 1535 West 62nd Street, Los Angeles, CA 90047, and the non-exclusive use of two tennis courts at Saint Andrews Recreation Center located at 8701 Saint Andrews Place, Los Angeles, CA 90047, for the operation of a youth tennis program and related activities.

Fiscal Impact Statement: The Board of Recreation and Park Commissioners reports that the proposed Agreement will have no adverse fiscal impact on the RAP General Fund, as the PBJTP is a self-sustaining program, and operational and program costs will be covered by PBJTP.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

On June 21, 2024, your Committee considered the June 7, 2024 Board of Recreation and Park Commissioners report relative to the proposed agreement with PBJTP for the non-exclusive use of tennis courts at Jackie Tatum Harvard Recreation Center and Saint Andrews Recreation Center, for the youth tennis program.
