

RULES, ELECTIONS AND INTERGOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS and NEIGHBORHOODS AND COMMUNITY ENRICHMENT COMMITTEES' REPORT relative to a proposed framework for youth participation in the Independent Redistricting Commission (IRC) as written in the City Attorney report dated May 30th, 2024, and allowed for by ordinance in the Los Angeles Unified School District (LAUSD) IRC ballot language Sec. 811 (c) and related matters.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Hernandez - Soto-Martinez):

INSTRUCT the Youth Development Department, in collaboration with the Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA), and request the LAUSD and community-based organizations focused on youth and student organizing and advocacy, to report on a proposed framework for youth participation in the IRC as written in the City Attorney report dated May 30th, 2024, and allowed for by ordinance in the LAUSD IRC ballot language Sec. 811 (c).
