

PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE REPORT relative to commissioning a study exploring the viability of constructing a grade separation connecting Alameda Street and Lomita Boulevard to divert commercial truck traffic from surrounding residential areas.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Motion (McOsker - Hutt):

INSTRUCT the Bureau of Engineering, with the assistance of the Los Angeles Department of Transportation, to report with the necessary steps to commission a study that would explore the viability of constructing a grade separation connecting Alameda Street and Lomita Boulevard to divert commercial truck traffic from surrounding residential areas.
