**REQUEST FOR CLOSED SESSION PURSUANT TO  
GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 54956.9(d)(2) and (e)(2)**

Honorable Members:

This Office recommends that discussion with, and advice from, legal counsel regarding the recommendation for City Council action be scheduled and held in closed session pursuant to California Government Code Sections 54956.9(d)(2) and (e)(2) (one case).

Government Code Section 54956.9(g) requires you to state publicly, prior to the closed session, what subdivision of this section authorizes the closed meeting, and that the closed session is being held to confer or discuss with, or receive advice from, legal counsel regarding significant exposure to litigation.

Government Code Section 54956.9(e)(2) requires you to state publicly, prior to the closed session, the facts and circumstances that might result in such litigation against the City. The facts and circumstances here involve the flooding event at the Hyperion Water Reclamation Plant on July 11, 2021.
