The community has never been notified about this project. I live on Olinda, which is a densely populated street, mixed with unexplainable industrial and residential zoning that has been a cancer Sun Valley community for over 40 years, and the havoc continues. That's not enough, our community is NEVER timely notified about projects coming to the community, nothing goes through the proper channels. such as SVANC. The Neighborhood Council is supposed to receive these notifications and provided a chance to bring it up to for public input, comments, requests, and a chance to ask questions. We do not know anything about this and other similar housing projects coming to Sun Valley, we only learn about it here, at the council meetings when everything has already been decided for us for the powers up high.
