I THEREFORE MOVE that the City Council instruct the Department of Public Works to research existing best practices in co-locating a bike path adjacent to a dog park. The Department of Public Works shall report back in 60 days with a summary of this research and design recommendations for this portion of the bike path informed by this research.
