

AD HOC COMMITTEE FOR LA RECOVERY REPORT relative to requesting the Los Angeles Department of Water and Power (LADWP) to report on why certain areas of the City are more susceptible to power outages compared to others, what factors contributed to the disproportionate impact of outages around the City and what contingencies the LADWP has to address these impacts.

Recommendation for Council action, as initiated by Motion (Nazarian – Rodriguez):

REQUEST the LADWP to report to Council:

- a. On why certain areas of the City are more susceptible to power outages compared to others, what factors contributed to the disproportionate impact of outages around the City, and what contingencies the Department has to address these impacts.
- b. With a strength, weaknesses, opportunities and threats (SWOT) analysis on the City's power grid and water supply infrastructure. This report should include data on recent outages in relation to the recent wildfires, Hurricane Hillary and the age of our infrastructure.
