Honorable Members:

The Office recommends discussion with, and advice from, legal counsel regarding the recommendation for City Council action be scheduled and held in closed session pursuant to California Government Code Sections 54956.9(d)(2) and (e)(2) (one case).

Government Code Section 54956.9(g) requires the issuance of a public statement that includes the section subdivision that authorizes the closed meeting, and determines whether the closed session will be held to confer or discuss with, or receive advice from legal counsel regarding significant exposure to litigation, prior to the closed session

Government Code Section 54956.9(e)(2) requires the issuance of a public statement citing the facts and circumstances that might result in such litigation against the City, prior to the closed session. The facts and circumstances here involve the sanitary sewer overflow near the 6th Street Bridge on July 18, 2016.
