

NEIGHBORHOODS AND COMMUNITY ENRICHMENT and RULES, ELECTIONS, AND INTERGOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS COMMITTEES REPORT relative to the feasibility of granting community councils the same privileges as those afforded to neighborhood councils under Los Angeles Administrative Code (LAAC) Section 22.819.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Park – Hernandez):

INSTRUCT the Department of Neighborhood Empowerment, with the assistance of the City Attorney, to explore the feasibility of granting community councils the same privileges as those afforded to neighborhood councils under LAAC Section 22.819. This report should include an overview of legal and charter considerations, in addition to Brown Act compliance.

On February 21, 2024, the Neighborhoods and Community Enrichment Committee considered Motion (Park – Hernandez) relative to the feasibility of granting community councils the same privileges as those afforded to neighborhood councils under Los Angeles Administrative Code Section 22.819 and related matters. The Motion attached to the Council file includes some background on the matter. After providing an opportunity for public comment, the Committee moved to approve the recommendation detailed above.

On April 19, 2024, the Rules, Elections, and Intergovernmental Relations Committee considered the matter and concurred with the actions taken by the Neighborhoods and Community Enrichment Committee on February 21, 2024. This matter is now transmitted to the Council for its consideration.
