Comments for Public Posting: I live in the residential neighborhood above Bacari Playa Del Rey restaurant located at 6805 S Vista Del Mar Ln, Playa Del Rey, CA 90293. This was a quiet neighborhood until Al Fresco dining was allowed. Bacari added two huge circus style tents to their parking lot, eliminating all customer parking and 10Xing their capacity. Later Bacari installed a loud outdoor stereo system and began offering a "\$30 all you can drink" special to the patrons with only ONE unisex bathroom for ALL customers. The music at night is VERY loud and customers drink and agree, many times as late as midnight (even on weeknights). The negative effects have been significant, parking has spilled out into the neighborhoods, as did the heavily intoxicated customers leading to several car accidents, many hit and runs. Word got out to the college students about the "\$30 all you can drink" special, which lead to a drunk fest, fights and heavily over-served patrons. The ONE-bathroom situation has resulted in Bacari drunk patrons wandering into residential neighborhoods peeing on residential properties. I personally have several Ring videos of Bacari patrons urinating on the side of my home, and in my private entry by my front door. Al Fresco dining was a wonderful gesture by city allowing outdoor dining to help restaurants bounce back from Covid losses, and our neighborhood has been patient and understanding, however this does not work well as a long-term solution. The effects on our neighborhood have been significant, Al Fresco dining has served its purpose and should be immediately terminated.
