

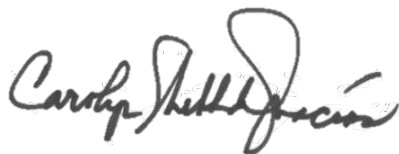

DISCUSSION

This donation will provide repair of the ARTC's obstacle course. During a recent Basic Course Certification Review (BCCR) conducted by the California Commission of Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST), it was determined that portions of the obstacle course wall and fence did not meet specifications. Approval of this donation will allow the ARTC to continue to operate the mandatory test that all recruit officers take during their academy training and ensure that the Department meets POST standards to have an accredited Police Academy in the State of California. Below is a list of items to be donated, along with their estimated value.

It is requested that Training Division be approved for a repair to the Ahmanson Recruit Training Center's (ARTC) obstacle course from the Los Angeles Police Foundation (LAPF), valued at \$32,602.50. Approval of this donation benefits the Department as follows:

The ARTC is one of three Academy facilities that conducts recruit training for the Los Angeles Police Department. This obstacle course is a mandatory test that all recruit officers take during their academy training and is part of the training specifications directed by the California Commission of Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST). A Basic Course Certification Review (BCCR) was recently conducted by POST, where it was determined that portions of the obstacle course wall and fence did not meet their specifications.

This grant is being requested to hire a contractor to update the existing obstacle course at ARTC to meet the requirements set by POST. The repair of the obstacle course's wall and fence will allow ARTC to continue to operate and meet POST standards to have an accredited Police Academy in the State of California. Below are the anticipated expenditures for this project:


