**Comments for Public Posting:** I respectfully request that you OPPOSE Council File 23-1200-S122. Regarding Mayor Bass' nomination of Ilissa B. Gold, President of Abundant Housing LA to the City Planning Commission. Ms Gold is an advocate for bills such as Senate Bill 4, which seeks to silence the voice of community members by granting the City / State the authority to build homeless shelters, on any property owned by a house of worship, even when that property is located within a zone designated as single-family housing only. Ms. Gold opposed Senate Bill 31 which would have provided our children with increased safety in and around their schools by providing a 1000 ft. No Encampment Zone around them. After more than a decade of corruption in City Hall, perpetrated primarily through land use deals, the residents of Los Angeles deserve to have a meaningful voice in all land use projects proposed for implementation in our communities. Ms. Gold's approach will be the "same old" solution--Housing First with no support services for those who need it. The proliferation of encampments all over the City provides ample evidence the solutions she supports simply do not work. After more than a decade of having our basic human right for safety being removed to make way for seriously mentally ill and addicted persons to live without any restrictions - We must regain our rights by having representation which includes us, rather than seeking to exclude and prevent community participation.
