

ENERGY AND ENVIRONMENT COMMITTEE REPORT relative to an agreement with Jacobs Project Management Co., for Owner's Agent services for the Water Quality Laboratory Project

Recommendation for Council action:

1. APPROVE the Los Angeles Department of Water and Power (LADWP) Resolution authorizing the execution of Agreement No. 47819 with Jacobs Project Management Co. for Owner's Agent Services for the Water Quality Laboratory Project in an amount not to exceed \$8.25 million for a term of six years commencing upon execution.
2. AUTHORIZE, upon proper certification, the Chief Accounting Employee to draw demands on the Water Revenue Fund, in accordance with the terms of these agreements.

Fiscal Impact Statement: The City Administrative Officer (CAO) reports that there is no impact on the General Fund. The proposed Owner's Agent Agreement No. 47819 between the LADWP and Jacobs Project Management Co. for the Water Quality Laboratory Project includes an established not-to-exceed limit of \$7.5 million over the Agreement's six-year term. An additional ten percent owner's contingency amount of \$750,000 is included increasing the LADWP requested and total approved funding amount associated with the Agreement to \$8.25 million. The required funding has been budgeted by the LADWP and will be paid from the Water Revenue Fund.

Financial Policies Statement: The CAO reports that the request complies with the LADWP adopted Financial Policies.
