**RECOMMENDED ACTIONS**

1. That the Board of Police Commissioners (Board) REVIEW and APPROVE the attached application of Special Reward Payment.
2. That the Board TRANSMIT to the Mayor and City Council the Application for Special Reward Payment for review and approval.

**DISCUSSION**

On April 15, 2015, the City Council amended the Los Angeles Administrative Code and created a Hit-and-Run Reward Program Trust. This reward program was created to encourage community members to provide information leading to the identification, apprehension, and conviction, or resolution through civil compromise, of suspects who fail to stop and render aid at a traffic collision.

It is requested that the Board approve and transmit to the City Council the recommendation to approve this reward to be paid to the Claimant in the amount of \$25,000.00. The Claimant provided information that was vital in assisting with a fatal hit-and-run case DR No. 2304-06931. The Claimant positively identified the suspect as the hit-and-run driver, who was convicted and sentenced to three years in state prison.

On March 30, 2023, a 13-year old male victim, was crossing southbound on Orme Avenue at Whittier Boulevard, within a marked crosswalk. A motorcyclist traveling eastbound on Whittier Boulevard collided with the victim. The force of the collision caused the victim to lose his right leg. Following the collision, the motorcyclist returned to his motorcycle and fled the scene without rendering aid or identifying himself.

On March 31, 2023, a press release and video of the crash were released to the public through the Media Relations Division and various social media platforms soliciting the public's help in identifying the hit and run motorcycle rider.

On April 6, 2023, Detective Dan Ramirez, Serial No. 39299, and Officer Sae Ko, Serial No. 40042, met with the Claimant. The Claimant provided the officers video footage of the crash. The officers were able to identify the license plate of the hit and run motorcycle.

On April 11, 2023, Erwin Majano, a 31-year-old male, was identified as the suspect in the hit and run. Suspect Majano was subsequently arrested and booked for felony hit and run, California Vehicle Code Section 20001(a).

On May 26, 2023, The Los Angeles County District Attorney's Office filed one count of felony hit and run, Vehicle Code Section 20001(b)(2), against Suspect Erwin Majano (Court Case No. BA515355).

On August 26, 2023, Suspect Erwin Majano waived his right to a trial and pleaded guilty to felony hit and run. He was sentenced to three years in state prison.

It is the opinion of the investigating detective and the district attorney assigned to this case, that the information provided by the Claimant was vital in the arrest and conviction of the suspect, making the Claimant eligible to receive the reward payment.
