

PLANNING AND LAND USE MANAGEMENT (PLUM) COMMITTEE REPORT relative to potential amendments to Los Angeles Municipal Code (LAMC) Sections 91.7007.1 and 61.02 to improve the City's ability to abate erosion and flood hazards; and related matters.

Recommendations for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Raman - Yaroslavsky):

1. INSTRUCT the Los Angeles Department of Building and Safety, with the assistance of the City Attorney, to report within 60 days on potential amendments to Sections 91.7007.1 and 61.02 of the LAMC to improve the City's ability to abate erosion and flood hazards stemming from permitted or unpermitted grading work at any time during the year. The report should also include an assessment of resources that would be required to effectuate Section 61.02(c).
2. REQUEST the City Attorney to prepare and present an ordinance amending the LAMC to resolve code enforcement challenges associated with the definition of the rainy season, pursuant to the findings of the above-described report.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted

Summary:

At a regular meeting held on May 13, 2025, the PLUM Committee considered Motion (Raman - Yaroslavsky) relative to potential amendments to LAMC Sections 91.7007.1 and 61.02 to improve the City's ability to abate erosion and flood hazards; and related matters. After providing an opportunity for public comment, the Committee moved to approve the recommendations contained in the Motion. This matter is now submitted to the Council for consideration.
