Comments for Public Posting: I like the concept of al fresco dining but feel it works best away from pedestrians, away from the noise and pollution of streets, and away from parking with people drawing up, leaving, loading, unloading, and trying to monitor kids and set up walkers and wheelchairs. To ensure a satisfactory experience for everyone, the City must enforce that vendors: * do not block sidewalk traffic * do not remove any pre-existing parking spaces * are mandated to carry sufficient insurance to reimburse passers-by who fall due to food spills, customers pulling chairs out or staff moving unexpectedly * are mandated to carry sufficient insurance to reimburse passers-by whose clothing is spattered by fat or other stains from the dining area.
