On Saturday, January 7, 2017, 34-year old Eloise Elizarraraz was found shot to death in her car near the intersection of Harding Avenue and Tripoli Avenue in Sylmar. The night before her death, a witness overheard a heated argument between Ms. Elizarraraz and her ex-boyfriend, Jose Rodriguez, from whom she had recently separated. The detectives investigating this crime have identified Mr. Rodriguez as a suspect in this crime, but have not been able to locate him. Detectives are continuing to investigate this matter, and believe a reward may compel members of the public to provide information on the person responsible for this crime. The person or persons responsible for this crime represent an ongoing threat to the safety of the people of Los Angeles. Unless withdrawn or paid by City Council action, this offer of reward shall terminate on, and have no effect after, OCTOBER 14, 2017. The provisions of payment and all other considerations shall be governed by Chapter 12 of Division 19 of the LAAC Code, as amended by Ordinance Nos. 158157 and 166666.
