UNCLAIMED MONIES SEIZED INCIDENTAL TO ARREST TRUST FUND

Dear Honorable Members:

On August 19, 2024, the Los Angeles Fire Department (LAFD) requested an escheatment of \$1,351,401.00 from the Fire Hydrant Installation and Main Replacement Fund 336 to the Reserve Fund. This money has remained unclaimed for at least three years and is therefore eligible for transfer in accordance with the notification requirements of the City of Los Angeles Administrative Code Section 5.112, and current state law.

BACKGROUND

The State of California Government Code Section 50050-50055 provides that any money remaining unclaimed in the City Treasury for three years or more may become the property of the City after publication of a notice, provided that within the specified period of time, no verified complaint seeking to recover all or a designated part of the money is filed in a court of competent jurisdiction.

Attached herewith is LAFD's request to escheat monies from the Fire Hydrant Installation and Main Replacement Fund 336, the Office of the City Clerk's proof of publication advertisements dated October 17, 2024, and the subsequent notice and publications executed on October 24, 2024. These notices stated that on December 16, 2024, funds seized from August 9, 1985, through June 30, 1989, would become property of the City. As of the respective aforementioned dates, no claims have been filed. Per the City Council's instructions (CF No. 04-2206-S1), the Office of Finance has reviewed the escheatment eligibility and publication notices.



RECOMMENDED ACTION

In accordance with the authority of the State Government Code and City of Los Angeles Administrative Code, it is recommended that City Council, subject to approval of the Mayor, should:

1. INSTRUCT the Los Angeles Fire Department and the City Treasurer to process the sum of \$1,351,401.00 from the Fire Hydrant Installation and Main Replacement Fund No. 336; and,
2. REQUEST the Controller to TRANSFER all identified eligible monies to the City's Reserve Fund.

**SUBJECT: THE \$2.9 MILLION IDLE IN THE FIRE HYDRANT INSTALLATION AND
MAIN REPLACEMENT FUND – FUND 336**

The City Charter requires the Controller to verify and report to the Mayor and Council on the condition of all City funds. On July 13, 2023, this Office released a report on the status of idle Special Purpose Funds (Idle Special Funds) with no activity for two or more years (C.F. 23-0758). As part of our ongoing monitoring of Idle Special Funds, we identified the Fire Hydrant Installation and Main Replacement Fund (Fund 336), as being an Idle Fund administered by your Department. This Fund has been idle for over five years. **As of April 1, 2024, Fund 336 had a cash balance of \$2,903,414.** We believe a portion of this amount could be escheated and transferred to the Reserve Fund immediately.

In the attached September 22, 2009 memo (C.F. No. 10-0235), the Fire Department in consultation with the City Attorney determined that \$29,550,401 from Fund 336 was escheatable to the Reserve Fund. However, as directed by the Mayor and Council within the FY 2009-10 Budget, only \$28,800,000 of these funds were published and escheated. The difference of \$750,401 plus interest of approximately \$601,000, for a total of \$1,351,401 is escheatable, per California Government Code Sections 50050-50055.

In light of the current City's General Fund budget crisis, we recommend that your Department take the following actions to address the idle cash balance accumulating in Fund 336:

1. Submit a request to the Office of Finance's Treasury Services to escheat \$750,401 in accordance with California Government Code Sections 50050-50055; and then transfer the amount plus approximate interest of \$601,000, for a total of \$1,351,401 to the Reserve Fund.
2. Work with LADWP staff from Water Distribution Division's Business Arrangements Unit to identify and pay any valid outstanding invoices, and to verify whether outstanding encumbrances in Fund 336 are still needed. Any remaining amounts after all valid invoices have been paid should be transferred to the Reserve Fund.
3. Submit a request to close Fund 336 to the Controller's Office once all transactions have been completed and this Fund is no longer needed.

BACKGROUND

On February 18, 1981, the City Council established a fire hydrant installation revolving fund to equitably spread the cost of fire hydrant installations to beneficiaries of such public safety improvements (C.F. 81-0858). In June 1985, Ordinance No. 160086 established a Fire Hydrant Fee of 0.022 percent (after excluding developments valued at under \$50,000) applied to the value of a proposed development. At the same time, Ordinance No. 160087 established the Fire Hydrant Installation and Main Replacement Fund (Fund 336) to deposit monies collected from the Fire Hydrant Fee. The Department of Building and Safety collected the fee and the Fire Department was the fund administrator.

On March 20, 1986, Bixel Associates (Bixel), a developer, paid the fire hydrant fee in protest with a claim for refund made on June 20, 1986. The City neither granted nor denied Bixel claim, and accordingly the claim was deemed rejected by the City.

On December 21, 1989, Bixel successfully challenged the payment of this fee (Docket No. B037251). According to the California Court of Appeals, the fee was: (1) impermissible to charge new developments for citywide fire hydrant and water main installations; (2) the fire hydrant fee exceeded the reasonable cost of the services resulting in an invalid "special tax"; and (3) the fire hydrant fee violated the Fifth Amendment of the U.S. Constitution and Article 1, Section 19, of the California Constitution since the fee charged to developers exceeded the actual cost of the fire hydrant and/or water main. As a result, the Fire Hydrant Fee of \$135,520 was refunded to Bixel.

In July 1990, the City Council instructed the CAO, Fire Department, Building and Safety, Chief Legislative Office, LADWP and the City Attorney to reformulate the Fire Hydrant Fee (C.F. No. 86-1308). In 1991, Ordinance No. 166932 was adopted to allow for a claim for refund to occur within one year of paying the Fire Hydrant Fee.

Escheatment

According to California Government Code 50050 – 50055, unclaimed monies within the City treasury for three years, and after a notice is published, becomes property of the City. In March 2010, although \$29,550,401 was eligible, the City escheated \$28,800,000 from Fund 336 to the Reserve Fund (C.F. No. 10-0235). This leaves \$750,401 in the fund, with custody dates from August 9, 1985 to June 30, 1989, eligible for publication and escheatment. The \$750,401 should be submitted for escheatment, and the amount plus estimated interest of \$601,000, for a total of \$1,351,401 be subsequently transferred to the Reserve Fund.

Outstanding Encumbrances and Invoices

After escheatment is completed, there would still be approximately \$1.6 million remaining in the Fund. The remaining balance is tied to several old encumbrances set up to pay LADWP invoices. These old encumbrances and invoices should be reviewed to determine if they are still valid. The City's Financial Management System currently shows the following outstanding encumbrance and invoice documents:

The Fire Department in conjunction with the LADWP should review and pay all valid outstanding invoices. After all remaining obligations have been satisfied, the Fire Department should disencumber any remaining encumbrances, transfer the balance to the Reserve Fund and close Fund 336.



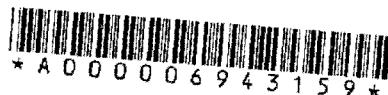
