

PUBLIC SAFETY AND RULES, ELECTIONS AND INTERGOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS COMMITTEES' REPORTS relative to a proposed June 2026 Election ballot measure for a bond providing funding for fire station maintenance and new fire station construction.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Park, Rodriguez – Padilla, Lee):

INSTRUCT that the City Administrative Officer (CAO), with the assistance of the Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA), the City Attorney, and Los Angeles Fire Department to report with recommendations in 60 days on a proposed ballot measure for the June 2026 Election which would seek to implement a Bond measure that would provide funding for the needed maintenance of current Fire Stations and capital for construction of much needed new fire stations, that would bring the Fire Department up to the standards needed for the next 50 years.
