**Comments for Public Posting:** I write in favor of California's Climate Superfund legislation and Cm. Yaroslavsky's motion for the City to formally support the proposals. Natural disasters are on the rise globally due to man-made climate change, overwhelmingly attributable to mega-corporations rather than individuals and state or local governments. California and Los Angeles in particular are ill-situated to cover the costs of recovery; we are still playing catch-up on the Altadena and Palisades fires in the wake of the Trump administration's politicized withholding of FEMA funds, and are further at decreased readiness to combat future fires during the President's illegal diversion of the National Guard to police Downtown. It makes no practical or ethical sense not to draw on the deep and culpable pockets of Shell, Chevron, and Exxon for relief.
