

STATUTORY EXEMPTION, ENERGY AND ENVIRONMENT COMMITTEE REPORT and ORDINANCE FIRST CONSIDERATION relative to the Navajo Large Generator Interconnection Agreement among Nextera Energy Resources Interconnection Holdings, LLC; Arizona Public Service Company; the City of Los Angeles, acting by and through the Los Angeles Department of Water and Power (LADWP); Nevada Power Company d/b/a NV Energy; Salt River Project Agricultural Improvement and Power District; Tucson Electric Power Company, and the United States of America Department of the Interior Bureau of Reclamation for the Q196 Generator Interconnection Project.

Recommendations for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

1. DETERMINE that the item is statutorily exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act Guidelines Section 15277.
2. CONCUR with the Board of Water and Power Commissioners' (Board) action of December 10, 2024, Resolution No. 20289, which approves the Large Generator Interconnection Agreement Between Nextera Energy Resources Interconnection Holdings, LLC and Arizona Public Service Company, LADWP, Nevada Power Company, Salt River Project Agricultural Improvement and Power District, Tucson Electric Power Company, and the United States of America acting through the Secretary of the Interior, Bureau of Reclamation for Q196 Generator Interconnection Project.
3. PRESENT and ADOPT the accompanying ORDINANCE dated January 14, 2025, approving the Navajo Large Generator Interconnection Agreement among Nextera Energy Resources Interconnection Holdings, LLC; Arizona Public Service Company; the City of Los Angeles, acting by and through the LADWP; Nevada Power Company d/b/a NV Energy; Salt River Project Agricultural Improvement and Power District; Tucson Electric Power Company, and the United States of America Department of the Interior Bureau of Reclamation (Contract No. 55889, DWP No. BP 23-008); and delegating to the Board authority to amend said agreement.
