

RULES, ELECTIONS AND INTERGOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS COMMITTEE REPORT and RESOLUTION relative to including in the City's 2025-26 State Legislative Program support for Assembly Bill 630 (Gonzalez), which will ensure inoperable RVs are removed from city streets by increasing the value cap for dismantling abandoned RVs, adding additional notifications and reporting requirements before a vehicle can be scrapped, and requiring that an RV that is inoperable or is a public safety or environmental hazard is scrapped.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Resolution (Yaroslavsky – Hutt),
SUBJECT TO THE CONCURRENCE OF THE MAYOR:

RESOLVE to include in the City's 2025-2026 State Legislative Program SUPPORT for Assembly Bill 630 (Gonzalez), which will ensure inoperable RVs are removed from city streets by increasing the value cap for dismantling abandoned RVs, adding additional notifications and reporting requirements before a vehicle can be scrapped, and requiring that an RV that is inoperable or is a public safety or environmental hazard is scrapped.
