

HOUSING AND HOMELESSNESS COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the creation of a department responsible for the development and management of the City's Homelessness Programs.

Recommendation for Council action, as initiated by Motion (Rodriguez – Padilla):

INSTRUCT the Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA), with the assistance of the City Attorney, the City Administrative Officer (CAO), the Los Angeles Housing Department and the Los Angeles Homeless Services Authority to evaluate the creation of a City department of homelessness or other means of centralizing coordination and oversight of the following, as well as other issues identified by the CLA:

- a. The coordination of City funded outreach deployments including those related to sanitation and encampment response and coordination with the County.
- b. The Identification and development of potential sites for interim and permanent housing.
- c. Collection of real-time data related to homelessness and accountability of service providers.
- d. Contracting processes.
- e. Emergency response.
- f. Homelessness prevention.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the CAO nor the CLA has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted

### SUMMARY

At the meeting held on April 17, 2024, your Housing and Homelessness Committee considered a Motion (Rodriguez – Padilla) relative to the creation of a department responsible for the development and management of the City's Homelessness Programs.

After an opportunity for public comment was held, the Committee moved to approve the recommendation contained in the Motion as amended by Councilmember Raman to replace the original moving clause, as detailed above. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
