

AD HOC COMMITTEE FOR LA RECOVERY and BUDGET AND FINANCE COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the feasibility and steps necessary to authorize the temporary reemployment of retired employees to aid in the City's wildfire recovery and rebuilding efforts.

Recommendations for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Park, McOsker – Lee):

1. INSTRUCT the City Administrative Officer (CAO) to report in 15 days on:
 - a. The feasibility and steps necessary to authorize the temporary reemployment of retired employees to aid in the City's wildfire recovery and rebuilding efforts, using lessons learned from the Northridge Earthquake.
 - b. On possible funding sources for these positions, including, but not limited to, the use of Salaries As-Needed accounts.
2. INSTRUCT the CAO and the Personnel Department to report in 15 days on the use of Targeted Local Hire and Bridge to Jobs hiring programs as a source of streamlining hiring for these positions.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the CAO nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted

SUMMARY

At the meeting held on February 6, 2025, your Ad Hoc Committee for LA Recovery considered a Motion (Park, McOsker – Lee) relative to the feasibility and steps necessary to authorize the temporary reemployment of retired employees to aid in the City's wildfire recovery and rebuilding efforts.

After an opportunity for public comment was held, the Committee moved to approve the recommendations contained in the Motion, as detailed above.

Subsequently, on February 18, 2025, the Budget and Finance Committee also considered this matter and after providing an opportunity for public comment, the Budget and Finance Committee concurred with the recommendations made previously by the Housing and Homelessness Committee.

This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
