It is requested that West Los Angeles Area be approved to accept a donation of Automated License Plate Recognition (ALPR) Camera equipment, extended warranty service, and hardware installation, in and around neighborhoods that have been victim of the rise of residential burglaries. The donated equipment and services are valued at approximately \$202,000.

Approval of this grant benefits the Department and West Los Angeles Area community by facilitating the implementation of several new technology initiatives in support of crime reduction, situational awareness, and officer safety. In addition, the Department overall will benefit from the donation as it will support the Department as a national leader in policing technology.

There are no service contract fees associated with this donation. This donation includes the purchasing of an extended warranty for the ALPR Camera equipment. The usage of the ALPR Camera equipment will comply with Department ALPR policy and procedures. The Los Angeles Police Foundation will coordinate with the Department on the selection of the ALPR vendor.


The ALPR cameras will be installed in the Cheviot Hills Community at the following intersections:

- (2) Northbound/Southbound Motor Ave at Walavista Rd
- (2) Eastbound/Westbound Northvale Rd at Putney Rd
- (1) Eastbound Beverlywood St at Beverwil Dr
- (1) Southbound Shelby Dr at Burgen Ave
- (1) Westbound Kincaradine Ave at Club Dr
- (2) Eastbound/Westbound Barbydell Dr at Club Dr
- (2) Eastbound/Westbound Ashby Ave at Manning Ave

Captain Anthony Espinoza from Innovation Management Division advised that the technology meets the Department and City standards and can be reached for further questions regarding the equipment.
