

ENERGY AND ENVIRONMENT AND BUDGET AND FINANCE COMMITTEES' REPORT relative to the strategy for integrating climate considerations into the City budgeting process.

Recommendations for Council action:

1. AMEND the prior Council Action of February 22, 2023, Council file No. 22-1402, to change the last sentence of Recommendation No. 1 to read as follows: The inventory should be finalized and presented to the Council by March 1 of each year and used to inform the subsequent year's budget process.
2. INSTRUCT the Bureau of Sanitation, Los Angeles Fire Department, Department of General Services, and other relevant departments, with assistance from the Chief Legislative Analyst, to report on the existence and feasibility of using vehicles that can reduce municipal emissions that will help achieve the City's net-zero emissions goals.
3. NOTE and FILE the City Administrative Officer report dated August 7, 2024 relative to the strategy for integrating climate considerations into the City budgeting process.
