

PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE REPORT relative to an Historical Monument sign stating: "Philippine Village: Former Hub of Eagle Rock's Filipino Community and Home to the Nation's First 24-hour Radio Station Dedicated to Filipino Americans, Radio Manila", located in front of the former site at 4515 Eagle Rock Boulevard in Eagle Rock.

Recommendations for Council action, pursuant to Motion (de León - Lee):

1. AUTHORIZE the Los Angeles Department of Transportation (LADOT) to fabricate an Historical Monument sign stating: "Philippine Village: Former Hub of Eagle Rock's Filipino Community and Home to the Nation's First 24-hour Radio Station Dedicated to Filipino Americans, Radio Manila."
2. INSTRUCT the LADOT to install the double-sided sign on the streetlight pole located in front of the former site at 4515 Eagle Rock Boulevard, Eagle Rock.
