The need for childcare is especially acute during the summer when most children are not in school. Working parents are often not able to or severely inconvenienced by the need to provide childcare for the entire duration of the summer break. Los Angeles' recreation centers have an 8 week summer camp that can fill this gap in childcare and is particularly essential for supporting youth living in under-resourced communities.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the Council direct the City Clerk to transfer \$436,180 from the Council District 14 Public Benefits Trust Fund Department No. 14, Fund No. 57L, Account No. 140001 to the Department of Recreation and Parks, Fund No. 302, Dept No. 89, Account No. SP724H00 (Sports and Cultural Programming - CD14) for Council District 14 families participation in Department of Recreation and Parks camp during Summer Break

I FURTHER MOVE that the Department of Recreation and Parks be authorized to make any corrections, clarifications, or revisions to the above fund transfer instructions, including any new instructions, in order to effectuate the intent of this motion
