**NOTE:** Community Software Solutions (CSS) is a vendor that provides a payroll service platform used by some of the sub-recipients to pay Participant (Youth) wages and benefits. The CSS contract is managed by EWDD and coordinates with CSS to pay participants on a bi-weekly basis. In CFAY Cycle 2, existing non-enrolled sub-recipients may elect to pay using CSS; thus, the proposed Contract may be expanded to include up to the 17 projects. Otherwise, those not enrolled will use their payroll platform/software, such as ADP, PeachTree, QuickBooks, etc.
