

PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE REPORT relative to a comprehensive plan to close Blinn Avenue between Lomita Boulevard and Sandison Street to all vehicular traffic, as well as to restrict vehicular access to Drumm Avenue by creating cul-de-sacs at the intersections of Drumm and Cruces Street, 0 Street, and Colon Street.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Motion (McOsker – Hernandez):

INSTRUCT the Bureau of Engineering, with the assistance of the Los Angeles Department of Transportation, to report with a comprehensive plan to close Blinn Avenue between Lomita Boulevard and Sandison Street to all vehicular traffic, as well as to restrict vehicular access to Drumm Avenue by creating cul-de-sacs at the intersections of Drumm and Cruces Street, 0 Street, and Colon Street. The plan should include a full scope of work and budget for both projects, with a report to Council within 90 days.
